
HP Firmware Update Notice for Printers that Use 902 Cartridges

HP released a wireless firmware update for on April 9th that may interrupt your use of compatible HP 902XL ink cartridges. Updating to this latest firmware version may prompt a cartridge problem message on your printer's display, preventing you from using compatible cartridges.
